## 'Flanders' Code of Conduct:

To ensure that the safety and enjoyment of everyone is paramount at all times, the following is issued:

1. Behaviour is expected to be excellent at all times whether on the coach, towns, sites, hotel or ferry. Students must act as ambassadors.
2. Students will be given opportunities to enjoy a "continental" experience however meeting times and arrangements must be maintained.
3. Respect is to be shown at the sites and places that are visited.
4. Any unexploded shells are to be left alone and not touched or interfered with under any circumstances.
5. Staff will reserve the right to approve the purchase of any souvenirs and confiscate any thing that is deemed to be inappropriate.
6. The purchase/consumption of alcohol/tobacco is not permitted.
7. Mobile phones are permitted on the trip but for the contact of home only, not for use at the sites visited (nor any electronic equipment).
8. Infringements of the above will jeopardise future visits and result in appropriate action by staff.
9. Serious misconduct (defined by the Group leader) will result in a student being escorted to Dover for collection by his/her parents.
